

Why should staff in long-term care facilities get the COVID-19 vaccine?



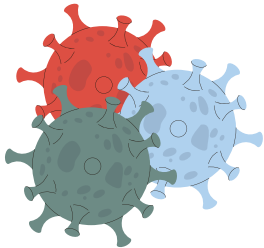
More money now, longer vacations later
